**NOTIFICATION OF THE LAUNCH OF FORMAL CONSULTATION FOR THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF CONTROLLED AIRSPACE AT NORWICH INTERNATIONAL
AIRPORT - AIRSPACE CHANGE PROPOSAL**

This letter is to advise you that Stage 3 – Preparing for Consultation – for Norwich’s Airspace Change Proposal for the establishment of controlled airspace at the Airport has been completed in accordance with the CAP 725 – CAA Guidance on the Application of the Airspace Change Process.

Norwich commenced Stage 4 – Consultation and Formal Proposal Submission – by launching the formal consultation on 21 April 2009. The consultation is due to close on 28 July 2009. Following successful completion of Stage 4, the Change Sponsor will submit the Airspace Change Proposal to DAP. Further notification will be given upon receipt of the Proposal.

In order to gain regulatory approval, the Proposal will need to satisfy the regulatory requirements as demonstrated through the quality of the operational and environmental analysis and the thoroughness of the consultation. The DAP Project Leader is Dean Miller of the Controlled Airspace Section.
