**RELEASE OF CONTROLLED AND SEGREGATED AIRSPACE: DISESTABLISHMENT OF
RAF LYNEHAM CONTRL ZONE (CTR), CONTROL AREA (CTA) & AIR TRAFFIC ZONE
(ATZ)**

The Directorate has held a RCSA Framework Briefing with RAF Lyneham on the disestablishment of the RAF Lyneham CTR, CTA and ATZ.

RAF Lyneham will cease routine operational flying on 30 September 2011. At this stage the Lyneham CTR and CTA will be disestablished and the resident Air Traffic Control Unit will close. However, the ATZ will be required until the unit's formal closure on 31 December 2012 as aircraft movements may still take place. Air Traffic Services for fixed-wing traffic operating at RAF Lyneham for the period 1 October 2011 to 31 December 2012 will be provided on a tactical basis.
