NATS are holding a 12-week consultation (and is seeking your feedback) on the "Harmonisation of the Transition Altitude, Procedures and Airspace Designation in the South East region of England and Re-Designation of Daventry Class C Airspace" proposal, abbreviated as "SE England TA". This consultation is open to any interested party, launches **8th April 2011** and closes **1st July 2011**.

NATS does not intend to introduce any new Controlled Airspace as a result of this re-designation.

The proposed implementation date for this change is Thursday 8th March 2012.
