

RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS – RALLY GB 2009 23-25 OCTOBER 2009

1. The Wales stage of Rally GB 2009 will take place at various sites in South Wales from 23 to 25 October 2009

2. Restricted Areas (Temporary) (RA(T)) will be established for nominated areas in South Wales for reasons of public safety. During the rally numerous aircraft (fixed and rotary wing) will be involved in the filming and onward relay of data for broadcast. In addition, a number of helicopters will be transporting race officials and VIP guests to strategic points along the route. Pilots should not be expected to make unscheduled violent changes in speed, altitude or direction in order to avoid other conflicting aircraft. Any distraction caused by unauthorised aircraft entering the RA(T) conflicting with the flight path of the aircraft flying in support of the event could result in a collision between aircraft. Therefore the Secretary of State for Transport has deemed it necessary to introduce the following Restriction of Flying regulations under Article 96 of the ANO 2005 (military aircraft should comply with JSP552 201.135.9):
 - a. Subject to paragraph (b), during the dates specified in column 2 of the table and during the period specified in column 4 of the table, no aircraft is to fly within the area specified in column 1 of the table, below the altitude specified in column 3 of the table.

 - b. Paragraph (a) does not apply to:
 - (i) any aircraft in the service of the Chief Officer of Police for either Dyfed-Powys or South Wales;
 - (ii) any aircraft flying with the permission of International Motor Sports Ltd;
 - (iii) any aircraft in the service of the Air Ambulance Service;

(iv) any aircraft flying on behalf of the Civil Aviation Authority.
