NATMAC INFORMATIVE LETTER

NOTIFICATION OF RECEIPT OF THE P600 IRISH SEA AIRSPACE CHANGE PROPOSAL

This letter is to advise you that in accordance with our previous notification, dated 9 June 2008, the Directorate has now received the above titled airspace change proposal from NATS.

The Stage 4 Consultation period closed on 22 August 2008, and NATS have since produced a Stakeholder Consultation Feedback report, dated 27 August 2008, which can be accessed on the NATS website. This proposal is part of the UK/Irish Functional Airspace Block development and supports changes being made by the IAA to procedures within the Dublin TMA and their connectivity to the Scottish FIR.

In accordance with CAP 725, Stage 5 will now commence and regulatory approval will be given only if all regulatory requirements are satisfied.
