Following successful trials, listening squawks have now been introduced for aircraft flying in the vicinity of Manchester, Birmingham, Doncaster, Gatwick and London City, Luton and Stansted, Solent and Belfast. Points to remember

- Enter the appropriate listening squawk for the area, with Mode C if you have it
- Tune into the appropriate frequency and listen out, without transmitting
- ◆ Change back to 7000, with Mode C if you have it, when leaving the area or changing frequency

A listening squawk does NOT...

- Clear you into controlled airspace
- Mean that you are receiving any ATC service

If you need an air traffic service, contact either the appropriate ATC frequency or London/Scottish Information as required.
