- 7. Inadvertent slide deployment at Belfast, training issues. (5.7)
- 8. Concerns over positioning of second marshaller out of sight of captain when normal stand guidance unavailable. (5.8)
- 9. Helicopters also create wake turbulence and downwash. (5.10)
- 10. CAA specialist discussion on reporting system. (5.11)
- 11. HF issues: failure to set flaps during after-start checks and mis-selection of brake fans vice max autobrake pre-departure. (5.13)
- 12. Uncontrolled helicopter landing sites at hospitals leading to use of secondary landing sites with associated risk to patients. (5.14) (5.16)
- **13.** Commercial pressures leading to mistakes. Pressures to accept multiple lastminute manifest changes. (5.14)
