> VOLCANIC ASH NOTAMs. FROM THIS TIME THERE WILL BE TWO AREAS
> PROMULGATED FOR THE APPROPRIATE FIR/UIR. THE FIRST WILL BE A
> NO-FLY ZONE (NFZ)(ICAO DEFINITION: AREAS OF HIGH CONTAMINATION) THAT
> WILL EQUATE TO THE VAAC BLACK AREA AS DEPICTED ON
> WWW.METOFFICE.GOV.UK/AVIATION/VACC (FOLLOW THE LONDON VAAC-ISSUED
> GRAPHICS LINK).
> THE SECOND AREA THAT WILL EQUATE TO THE GREY AREA ON THE VAAC CHART
> WILL BE REFERRED TO AS A TIME-LIMITED ZONE (TLZ). FLIGHT WITHIN THE
> TLZ WILL BE AVAILABLE TO THOSE OPERATORS WHO HAVE AGREEMENT FROM
> THEIR ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER (OEM). AIRCRAFT WITHOUT SUCH
> AN AGREEMENT MUST TREAT THE TLZ AS A NFZ. IN ADDN THERE ARE VOLUMES
> OF AIRSPACE WHERE ADDITIONAL PROCEDURES MAY APPLY (ENHANCED PROCEDURE
> ZONES (EPZ) (ICAO DEFINITION: AREAS OF LOW CONTAMINATION). THE
> DIMENSIONS OF THE EPZ ARE AVBL FM THE VAAC, AVBL AT
> WWW.METOFFICE.GOV.UK/AVIATION/VACC (FOLLOW THE LONDON VAAC-ISSUED
> GRAPHICS LINK).
> UK ACFT OPR CERTIFICATE (AOC) HOLDERS PLANNING TO OPR WI AN EPZ OR A
> TLZ SHOULD COMPLY WITH THE LATEST FLT OPS DIVISION COM (FODCOM)
> DOCUMENTS, AVBL AT WWW.CAA.CO.UK (SEARCH FOR: FODCOMS PUBLICATIONS
> AND FODCOMS FOR GENERAL AVIATION). ALL NON-UK AOC HOLDERS PLANNING TO
> OPR WI THE EPZ OR A TLZ SHOULD SATISFY THEMSELVES THAT THEY ARE ABLE
> TO OPERATE SAFELY.

> EVERY 6 HR. THE FIRST NOTAM THAT WILL DEFINE BOTH THE NFZ AND TLZ IS
> LIKELY TO BE THE 1800-2359 NOTAM TO BE PUBLISHED ON 18 MAY.
