- 1. Airspace restrictions imposed for Ukraine concentrating traffic at the airspace margins, longer routings and ATC delays impacting on FTLs. (2.1)
- 2. CAT RTO called before V1 but acceleration took the aircraft beyond by the time action taken; safe stop. (2.2)
- 3. Communication and presentation of aero data: helicopter wire-strike after presence of wires reported. (2.3)
- 4. Reports on cutting corners to meet KPIs, more snags being carried. (2.4)
- 5. Post-maintenance aircraft collection and testing takes time and planning. (2.5)
